OR RCWA

RCW 46.61.440

Maximum Speed Limit When Passing School or Playground Crosswalks (partial).

(1) "Subject to RCW 46.61.400(1)...it shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to operate the same at a speed in excess of twenty miles per hour when operating any vehicle upon a highway...when passing any marked school or playground crosswalk...fully posted with standard school speed limit signs...The speed zone at the crosswalk shall extend three hundred feet in either direction from the marked crosswalk.

(3) A person found to have committed any infraction relating to school speed restrictions within a school...speed zone shall be assessed a monetary penalty equal to twice the penalty assessed under RCW 46.63.110. This penalty may not be waived, reduced, or suspended."
